Application Period: May - June 30, 2018

Notification Date: August 2, 2018

The search for resources for Christian education can be a daunting process for students and their families. This year, NEA is sponsoring the "NEA Academic Scholarship Program." This document provides a guide to the application process as well as pertinent information that we hope you find beneficial.

Selection Criteria

- Student must attend Northeastern Academy and be in good and regular standing. New students must show proof of admission before eligible to apply.
- Scholarships will be awarded to exceptional candidates from our application pool.
- Candidates must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Candidates are expected to exceed listed minimums while demonstrating a clear commitment to an advanced curriculum, achievement/distinction in other areas, and superior writing skills.

Application

Complete and submit the following documents for consideration:

- Application form
- Official transcript (from schools attended)
- Essay
- Letters of Recommendation (2)
- Resume
- Certificates and photograph

Essay Topic: What are your expectations from a Christian School and how can you help create that atmosphere?

Tips for the Resume

The resume is a chance to help your application stand out, but there is a good way and a bad way to stand out. Give your resume a professional appearance. Include information about organizations in which you have been involved or played a leading role, academic achievement, community service, and other important activities. The general length of the resume is one page.

Tips for the Essay

For many students the essay can be the most challenging part of the application. The essay is the best opportunity to help the scholarship committee to get to know you. **The most successful essays engage the prompts and reveal something about the applicant, not just the writing topic.** Proofread your essay a number of times and ask your English teacher to review it as well. The essay length is limited to 600 words. Essays cannot be updated or rewritten once they have been submitted.

Scholarship Award

3.0 – 3.4 GPA	4 year scholarship valued up to \$3,000.00 (\$750 per year)
3.5 – 3.7 GPA	4 year scholarship valued up to \$4,000.00 (\$1000 per year)
3.8 – 4.0 GPA	4 year scholarship valued up to \$5,000.00 (\$1250 per year)

Awards will be applied to tuition in February of each school year. Renewable only if award GPA is maintained.
