David Arthur Angle, 84, of Bowling Green died at 7:45 a.m., Saturday, Nov. 5, 2011 at his residence.

His father was a rural carrier who wanted to be near a college, so he traded routes and homes sight unseen with a carrier who wanted to go west. By June 1935 all four daughters had graduated from Western State Teachers College. After high school David was a World War II Army veteran and retired as a rural mail carrier after 30 years. He was a member of Eastwood Baptist Church. He was the son of the late William S. Angle and Kathrena Jostes Angle. He was preceded in death by his sisters, Alice A. Angle, Sadie A. McCombs, Elizabeth A. Larmon, and Rena Belle A. Thomas and brothers, William Lewis Angle and Joseph J. Angle.
