

Sophia Rollie

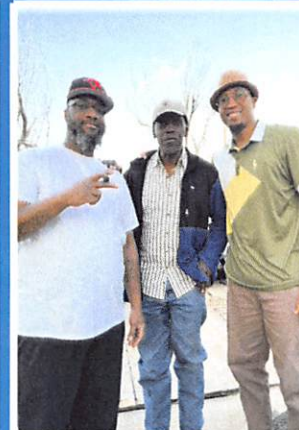
