Savannah Adventist Christian School **APPLICATION PROCEDURE (Step 1)**

For **new** students: The application form must be completed online. To access the application forms, visit www.sacssda.org and click on “Apply”.

All applicants must:

- Submit completed Online Application and application fee of \$50 (non-refundable)
- Schedule a family interview with the principal and classroom teacher(s)

High School applicants must also:

- Visit www.aaa.edu and click on “Apply Now”. (Apply for TruConnected campus--Savannah.)

K-8 applicants must also:

- Complete placement testing

Preschool-5th grade applicants must also:

- Submit a Recommendation Letter from a recent or current teacher or care-giver (if the child has been in school or daycare) or pastor (if the child has not been in school or daycare)
- NOTE: Children must be completely potty-trained to start Preschool or Pre-K.

6th to 8th grade applicants must also:

- Submit two (2) reference forms (from a pastor or youth leader and from a current Math or English teacher)
- Submit a handwritten student essay
- NOTE: These documents are accessed from the Online Application.

ENROLLMENT / REENROLLMENT PROCEDURE (Step 2)

For **returning** students (Preschool to grade 8): Reenrollment instructions will be sent by email.

For **new** students (Preschool to grade 8): After the application has been received and processed (usually within five to ten business days), parents will receive an email with instructions for completing the enrollment process. Open Enrollment begins the day after Spring Open House (late February or early March).

All students must submit the following forms every year:

- Current Immunizations Record (GA form)

If applicable, please also submit:

- Financial Aid Application (must be submitted before last day of current school year)
- Custody Documentation
- Driver Questionnaire

New students must also submit:

- Birth Certificate

For **High School**, enrollment requirements are set by Atlanta Adventist Academy.

**Please note that both steps must be completed before a new student will be able to attend classes.
Students who are returning only need to complete Step 2.**

Savannah Adventist Christian School welcomes applications, regardless of race, color, or national origin, from young people who are willing to uphold the values and traditions of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. Membership in the Seventh-day Adventist church is not required. Savannah Adventist Christian School supports inclusion in the classroom, but presently is not equipped nor has the resources to meet the needs of students who have physical, scholastic, psychological, or social limitations.

TUITION & FEES 2021-2022

Application Fee: A \$50 application fee is charged when you submit your application. This fee is non-refundable and is only charged one time per student. (High School application fee is in addition to the AAA application fee.)

Early Registration + Technology Fee (by March 15, 2021) \$525. (\$450 for ECC)

\$100 non-refundable deposit due via JupiterED with Online Enrollment by March 15 to guarantee your spot. To qualify for the Early discounted fee, your remaining balance will be due at the school office no later than June 1. If not paid by June 1, the balance will equal the fee listed below.

Registration + Technology Fee (after March 15, 2021): \$600. (\$525 for ECC)

High School Registration Fee set independently by AAA.

The registration fee helps to defray the costs of student insurance, curriculum & assessment materials, library expenses, technology resources, and instructional supplies. This yearly fee is non-refundable after the first day of school, and a service charge of \$25 will be charged for any refunds given before that date.

Enrollment of more than one child per family:

1. Full tuition for the first child.
2. Second child - \$30 per month discount (10-mo. plan).
3. Additional \$30 per month discount (10-mo plan) for each additional child.

Tuition may be paid in monthly installments due on the first day of each month. If payment is not received by the tenth of the month, a \$25 late charge will be added. It is school board policy to ask parents to withdraw their child from school if they become two months behind in payment. No school records will be transferred to another school until the school bill is paid in full. Payments may be made online (bank transfer preferred) or in the office (cash, check, or money order).

Discounts: Tuition discounts are offered for active military parents, Gulfstream employees, and for baptized members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. Inquire in the office for details. A discount will be applied in the office for cash or check payments. A five percent discount is allowed if the tuition is paid for the entire year in advance.

There will be a \$25 fee for any check that is returned by the bank. Personal checks will no longer be accepted from any family who has had a check returned by the bank.

***Ancillary Fees:**

Kindergarten & 8th grade – Graduation fee \$50 (payable in January)

A field trip t-shirt is required for all students, at \$20, and a hoodie sweatshirt/jacket is available for \$45. Please note that the cost of these items may increase if our vendors increase their price.

Parents are also responsible for before/after school care (\$8.00/hour/student), some field trip costs, hot lunch when available, etc.

* The school board reserves the right to adjust fees if deemed financially exigent.
