While many of the province's top players had to decline, the team featured a great variety of players, mixed from all different regions and age groups. The juniors were represented by Oisin Dunne, who scored a magnificent win over David Ayerst, while the seniors were represented admirably by Dave Borton. The teams were captained by Dan Zilic. It's not the first time that many of the province's top players were unavailable to represent Leinster, though it really meant a lot to the players who participated and they represented Leinster with great passion!

This is also the second year that the Leinster men's team didn't participate in the Inter-Counties event in English. While it's a pity, there really is a lack of motivation by the top players, and it saves Leinster Squash roughly ≤ 2000 .

Leinster Junior Squash 2012-2013

The Leinster junior squad annual training started last October 2012. A total of 92 juniors participated in the training.

66 juniors trained in Dublin using R.T.E, Leopardstown, Sutton and Santry courts.

18 juniors trained (many for the first time) in Carlow Lawn tennis club and 8 juniors trained in the Curragh.

Cost of 6 X 2hr sessions was €30.00. Training was from October to March and all sessions have been completed.

Leinster Junior Open, Carlow 2013

Carlow hosted the Leinster Junior Open 2013 with a total of 120 juniors which was up from 100 the previous year. 80 % of the juniors that participated in Leinster squad training played in this tournament. 85 entries were from Leinster with 51 from Sutton, 16 Carlow, 11 Mt Pleasant, 4 Fitzwilliam and 2 Naas. Mantis very kindly gave us all our rackets and bags at a very good rate.

This tournament attracted a lot of young players with many kids playing their first tournament. The entry in the U/11 was fantastic and we even had a boys U/9 which was a great success.

Inter Provincials 2013

The Inter Provincials were held in Mt Pleasant 6th/7th April. Leinster entered a team in all categories Boys U/13/15/17 Girls U/13/15/17 and a mixed U/19. Leinster took 5 out of 7 Categories. There were a total of 37 junior players involved in the tournament. Each junior received a hoody and 2 t-shirts for the tournament.

Sean Conroy, Oisin Logan and Griffin Gillanders represented Ireland in the U/19 European Championships in Switzerland.

Conor Moran, Sam Buckley & Scott Gillanders represented the U/13 teams at the Five Nations in France. Oisin Dunne, Luke Logan, Morgan Kelly, Sean Dineen and Stephanie Ryan represented the U/15 at the Five Nations also.

The European Championships are in May in Spain and Oisin Dunne, Luke Logan, Sean Dineen and Stephanie Ryan will represent the U/15 whilst David Ryan, Nikita Gileskiy and Griffin Gillanders will represent the U/17.

David Ryan won the U/17 Swiss Open, German Open and French Open.

All in all, it has been a great year for juniors in Leinster with the increase in the number of players probably the most pleasing. Regards,
