Georgia Income Tax Program Continues to Help SACS Families!

What is it called? Georgia Tuition Assistance Program (GATAP)

How does this program help SACS students? In 2020-2021, we were able to give SSO scholarships to 20 worthy students, for a total amount of over \$11,000. Praise God for the donors who helped us make a difference in these young lives!

How does this program help you? If you pay income taxes in the state of Georgia (either because you live here or because you work here), you can earn a dollar-for-dollar credit on your state income taxes (and a deduction on federal taxes if you itemize)!

When do I need to take action? Now!!! Although the state has authorized additional funds for this program, the best way to guarantee that you are approved is to apply before January 1st, but you may apply at any time. We would like your forms by December 15th so we can get them to GATAP by the end of December.
