Richard "Dick" Reyer was born on May 31, 1931, in Hudson, South Dakota to William and Bessie Reyer. Following high school, he attended South Dakota State University, graduating with a degree in Pharmacy. After college, he served in the U.S. Army as a Pharmacy Specialist in Fort Bliss, Texas. In 1954, Dick married Barbara Thompt, also from Hudson, SD, in El Paso, Texas. Dick practiced pharmacy, and he and Barb raised their five children in Winner, SD, St. Paul, MN, and Roseville, MN. In 1970, the family moved to Willmar, MN where Dick was the owner and pharmacist at Carlson Rexall Drug for a few years before becoming a pharmacist at White Drug.
