Rev. Alan writes...We Stand on Holy Ground! This week I am writing to invite you all to support a fundraising appeal for a new carpet for our parish church at St. Peter's. Anyone who has visited recently will no doubt have noticed how worn and tatty the carpet has become, which isn't surprising considering it is over 30-years old! The good news is we have gained planning permission, the PCC has selected a nice blue shade of carpet tile which is specially designed to allow wooden floors to breathe in old buildings, and the plan is to fit the new carpet tiles in early March.

The budget is £24,000 and we need to purchase 1,700 tiles, which equates to approximately £15 per tile. So, in true Blue Peter style, we've designed a 'Carpet-O-Meter' with 1,700 squares to allow us to track progress over the coming weeks. We can all help by purchasing a carpet tile or a number of tiles. One tile costs £15 and a square metre of 4 tiles costs £60. Here are the ways you can give:




