In 1970, she gave birth to her first-born Terrence D. Green. In 1973, she gave birth to her second child Tara T. Green. On July 29, 1977, she married Joseph L. Drayton who preceded her in death, and from that union came her third child LA'Wanda M. Drayton. Sandy as she was affectionately known worked in the healthcare field. In 1997, she moved to New Jersey and was employed at Virtua Hospital until she became disabled after an accident while riding on New Jersey Transit bus. Because of her disability she then returned home to her parents' home in North Philadelphia. While working she loved taking care of people and making them feel comfortable during their difficult time. Over the years her health started to decline.
