CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS/VISITORS

Rational:

At Greaves Adventist Academy, we believe students, staff and parents (or guardians) are entitled to a safe and caring environment in which to learn and work. Central to the Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians/Visitors is the understanding by each member of the school community of the behavioural expectations established by Greaves Adventist Academy. A willingness to accept responsibility for one's actions and conduct are fundamental to the Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians/Visitors.

The intention of the Code of Conduct is to clearly define the expected conduct for all Parents/Guardians/Visitors when they are at Greaves Adventist Academy School. This will enable us to continue to flourish and succeed in an atmosphere of mutual respect.

Aim:

That all members of the school community treat each other with respect.

Expectations:

In order to support a safe and caring environment, the school will not tolerate:

- Disruptive behaviour which interferes or threatens to interfere with the operation of the school or school sanctioned event.
- Using loud or offensive language, swearing, cursing or using profane language, in person or over the phone.
- Threatening harm or the use of physical aggression toward another adult or child.
- Harassment or intimidation of any kind.
- Abusive or threatening emails or text/voicemail/phone message or other written communications.

The above behaviours will be dealt with by the school administration and school board. The school and school board reserves the right to take any necessary actions to ensure that members of the school community are not subjected to abuse.

The School premises are private property and parents, guardians or visitors have been granted permission from the school to be on their premises. However, in the case of unacceptable behaviour, the school may ban parent(s) guardians(s) or visitor (s) from entering the school or its premises.

Unacceptable behaviour may result in the Police being informed.
