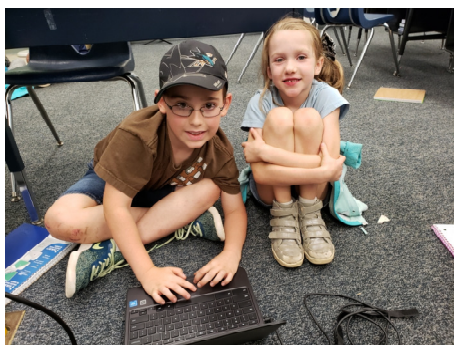

EXTENDED CARE

The Extended Care Program begins after school at 3:45 pm and runs until 4:30 pm on Monday through Thursday. On Friday, the program begins at 12:45 pm and closes at 1:30 pm. Parents or guardians must go through the check-out procedure with the director before taking their children from campus. This procedure is vital for your child's safety. Students who leave without checking out will be charged the maximum amount for that day. Accounts must be kept current for a student to continue in the after-school program.
