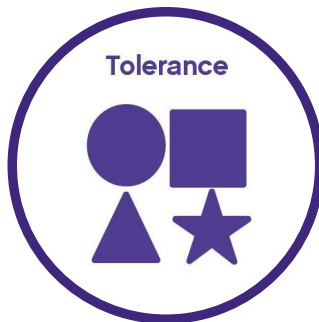

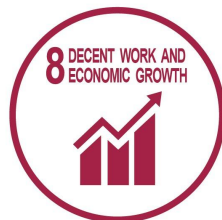


We team up with teachers and parents to develop **Social Emotional Learning** skills amongst our children and youth through a **play-reflect-act** framework.

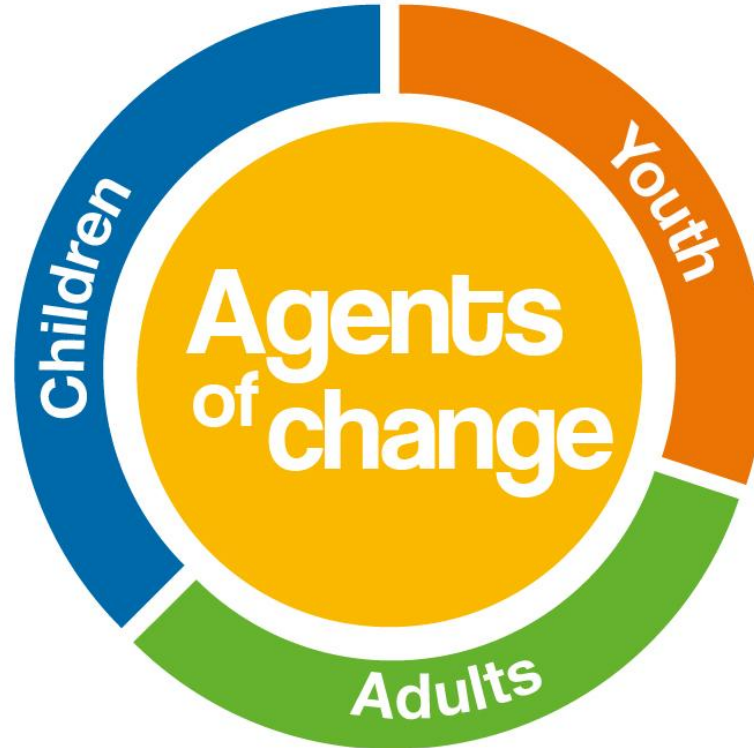

Fair play

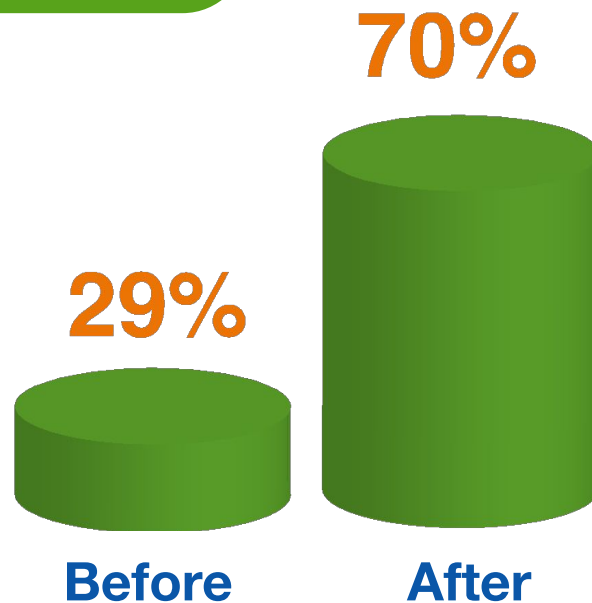

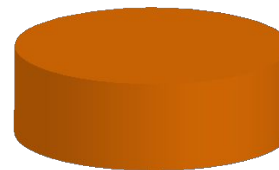
