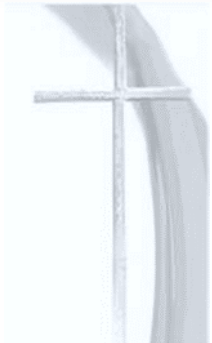

All we have now are memories

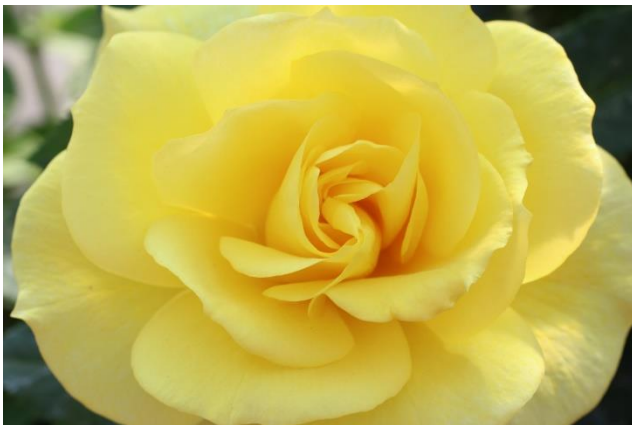
and your picture in a frame.

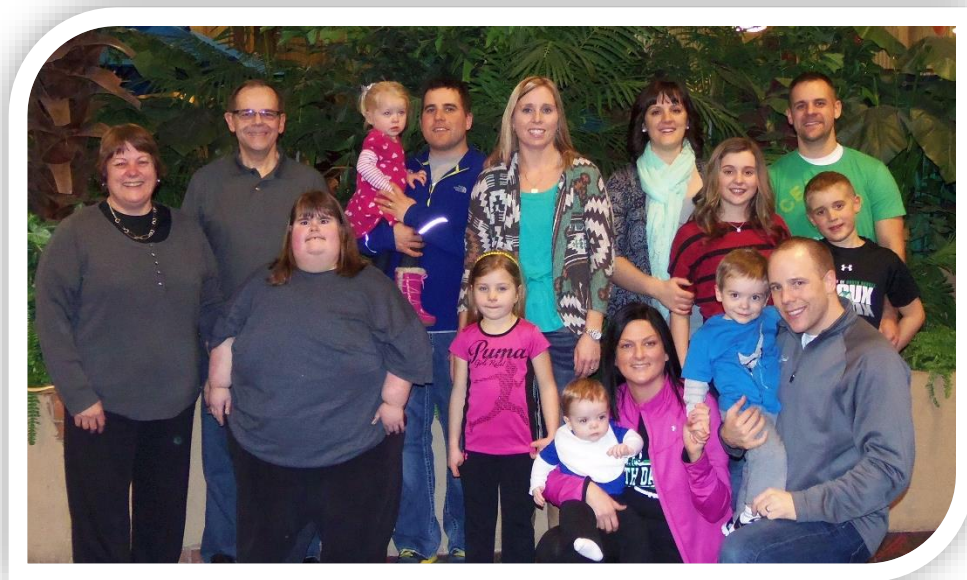
