#### *Regarding Sabbath Weekend, September 27 & 28*

Something amazing happened as the Disciples spent 10 days in prayer and fellowship after Jesus returned to Heaven. Luke describes their experience like this, "... there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit..."

Two chapters later the fledging church had encountered significant resistance and threats of death. This was a crisis, what would happen?

The disciples once again gathered and confirmed their commitment to Jesus and His gospel, and once again "...when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and spoke the word of God with boldness."

God knew His church needed another experience, another filling of the Holy Spirit. A confirmation that He was still with them. You might even call it a revival.

We need revival, too. Maybe it feels like God is distant, that faith is routine and uninspired. If this is the case, a revival of your first love, your connection to Christ, is what you need! ## Camp Wooten State Park September 20 – 22, 2019

### About the Facilities:

Camp Wooten is located on the Tucannon River in the Blue Mountains. There is a softball field, paved court for tennis and basketball, hiking available on forested and mountain trails, canoeing on Donnie Lake (canoes provided, flotation devices welcome – this is really more of a pond than a lake).

### Accommodations:

There is a 1930's era dining hall with fully equipped modern kitchen, 17 cabins that each sleep 11; cedar meeting hall with fireplace; several outdoor shelters; and restrooms and showers nearby. For those wanting to bring their RV's or trailers, please check with Stan for details.

### Other Notes:

Bedding is not provided. You must bring your own bedding and towels for showering & water recreation. The evenings can get chilly, please bring appropriate warm clothing.

### For Cabin Reservations:

There is a cabin sign-up sheet which has been posted at the information table the past several Sabbaths at church.

### Cost:

The rate for the week-end (not per night) is \$35.00 per family unit. Mom & Dad with kids = one unit. Grandpa & Grandma = one unit ☺). For a Single Adult, \$15.00. For those coming out just for the day the rate is \$5.00 per person per day. We do get charged for everyone who comes to the park. Payments are to be made to the church (with a note for Social Committee). Please hand payments to either Pastor Eric or Stan Maxted as you arrive at the camp if you have not already taken care of payment. We would like everyone to be able to go, if this price is a financial hardship, contact either of these two individuals for special arrangements. We want all to come!




