you've held such honor and grace

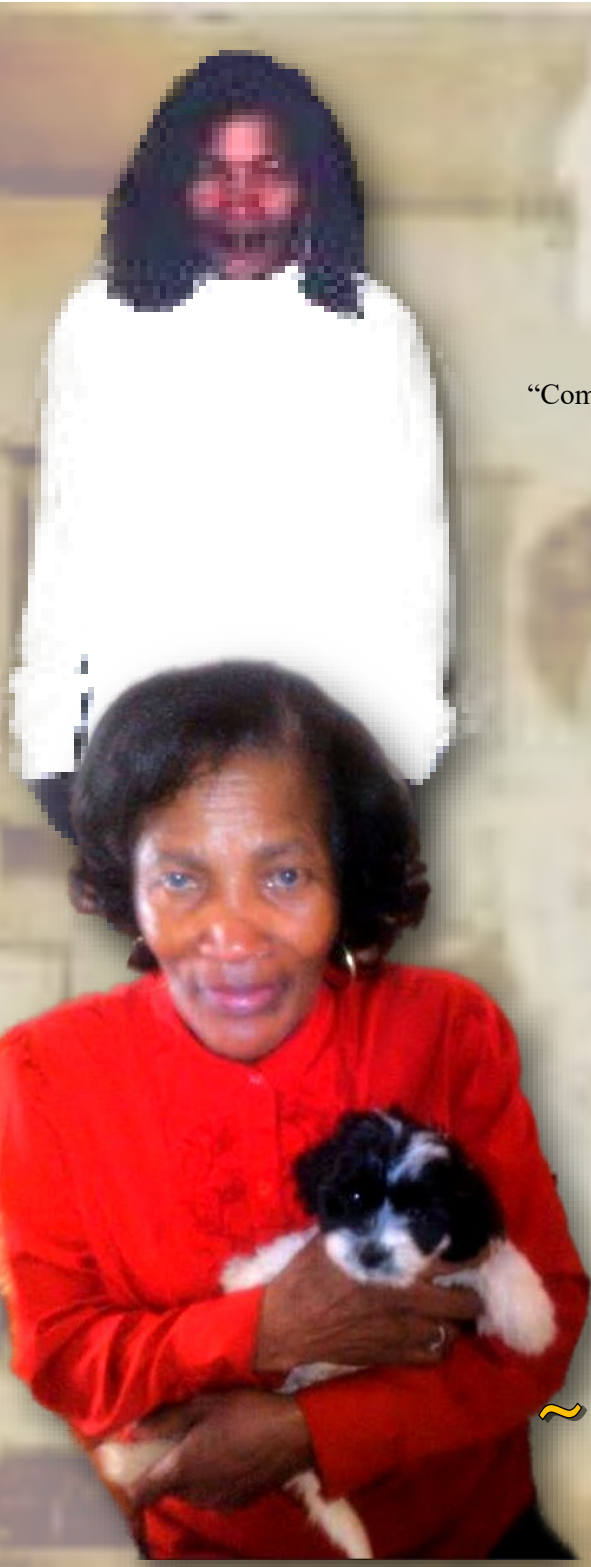
Your family loved you, strangers adored you

Beauty love and care, my dearest, rest well

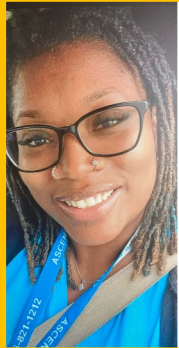

Loisteen Farley, 76, was born September 11, 1945 in Enid, Mississippi to Nathan Jefferson and Cecil McCaster.
