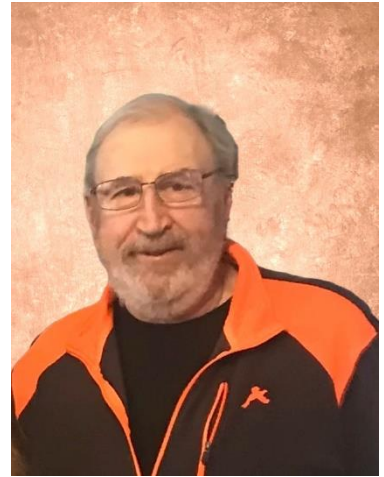


Raymond E. Lawrence
