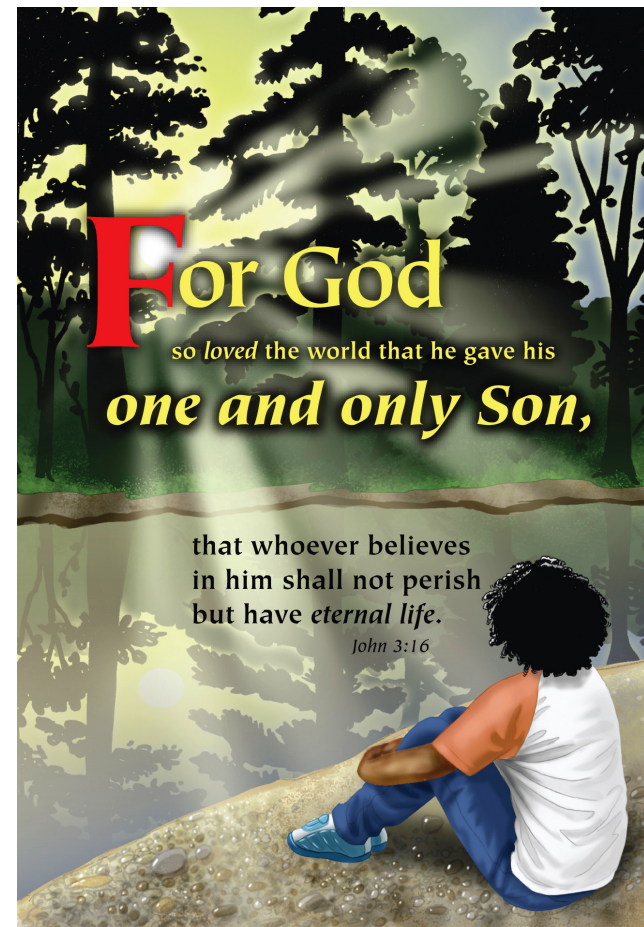

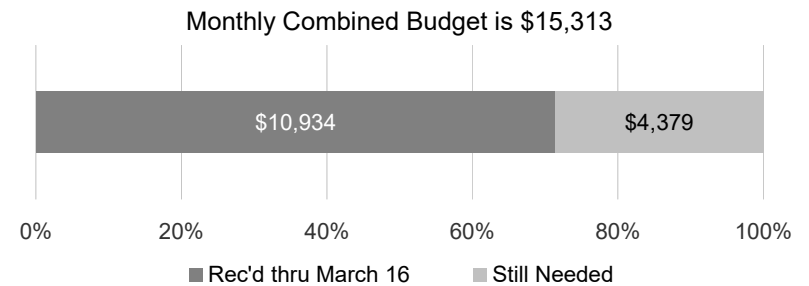
It's time to start thinking about our Church Campout—this year at the Deschutes River Recreation Area, Aug. 2-4. A sign-up sheet and more info coming soon..
