



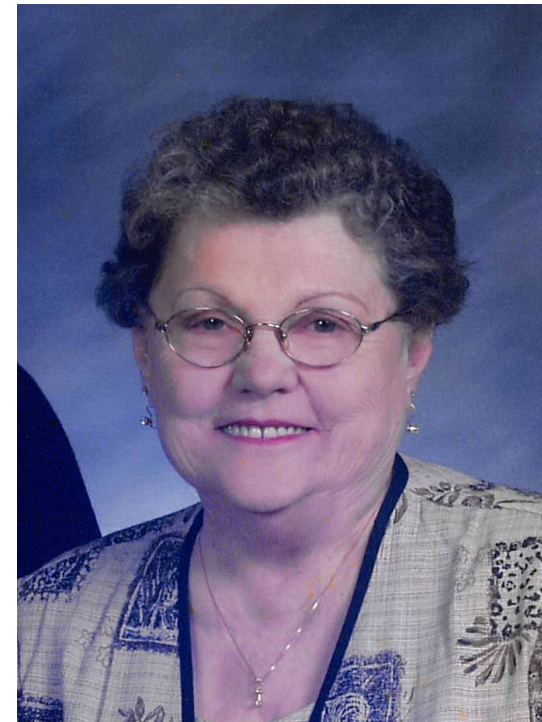
Legacy of Love
