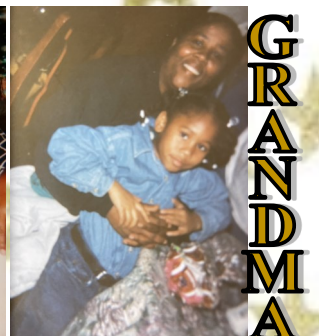
~ Reflections of Her Life ~
