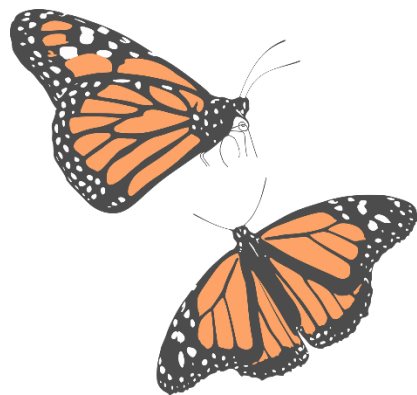


## Beyond the Sunset
