### **PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES**

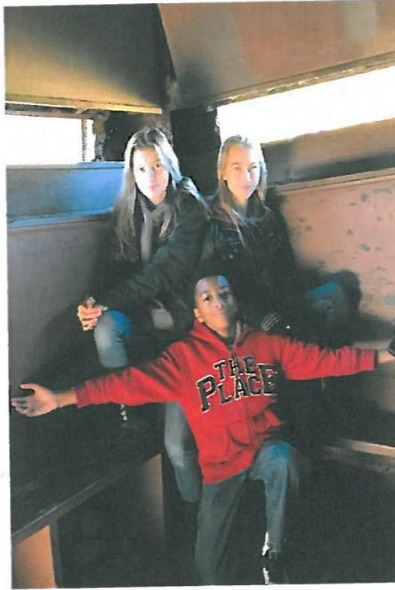
