Rev Alan writes...

My Church Commitment

Huge thanks to everyone who attended, and to the magnificent team of volunteers who worked so hard to make last week's parish-wide vision service at Bolton school such a special occasion. Almost 300 of us gathered and there was a lovely warm, friendly and relaxed atmosphere, a sense of belonging, and an expectation of all that is to come. It was the first time we have gathered as a parish for 5 years and I was excited to use the opportunity to share my vision for growth. Of course, I recognise that not everyone was able to join us and so I want to give you all the opportunity to hear my vision.









Title of the service was 'My Church Commitment'. It builds on the themes of 'My Church' we have covered in our services throughout the year. We have learned that the church belongs to Jesus Christ, you could say he bought it with his blood poured out for us when he died on the cross. As members of his church, we have the opportunity to gather each week to learn, grow and support one another as







followers of Jesus. But there is more to it than simply gathering. The bible shows that we gather as Jesus' family and that Jesus calls us as his church to a mission to reach out to a needy world with the good news of salvation.

I sum this up quite simply that the church is: *Jesus' Family on Jesus' Mission*.
