The research project is an extension of work initiated for MISI-ZIIBI: Living with the Great Rivers, a series of multi-disciplinary workshops investigating spatial design strategies and scenarios through the studying of innovative, integrated approaches for climate adaptation in various fluvial zones along the these three rivers. For the I-CARES funded project, a Climate Adaptation Performance Model (CAPM) will be developed to be the framework for future multidisciplinary MISI-ZIIBI workshops that will continue collaborations with partners such as The Royal Netherlands Embassy in Washington D.C., American Rivers, Earth Economics, the US Army Corps of Engineers, and local stakeholders. The CAPM is a crucial and instrumental intermediate benchmark in setting the long-term research methodology for a new design paradigm for how we live more sustainably within fluvial zones along the great rivers. This research work has conducted through Washington University in St. Louis and with colleague Associate Professor Derek Hoeflerin, and a great variety of partners including HKV, Amsterdam and Earth Economics.

The City of Wellston Public Housing Authority and St. Louis County

In partnership with St. Louis County wrote, submitted and was awarded a Choice Neighborhoods Planning Grant for the City of Wellston awarded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Choice Neighborhoods Program, as outlined by HUD (FY2013 Choice Neighborhoods Planning Grant NOFA) employs a comprehensive approach to neighborhood transformation. The intent of the program was to transform this neighborhood of concentrated poverty into a mixed-income neighborhood of long-term viability by revitalizing the severely distressed public and/or assisted housing; improving access to economic opportunities; and investing and leveraging investments in well-functioning services, effective schools and education programs, public assets, public transportation, and improved access to jobs. The Choice Neighborhoods program requires that current residents benefit from this transformation by preserving affordable housing in the neighborhood or providing the choice to move to affordable housing in another neighborhood of opportunity. This two year planning project resulted in a Transformation Plan for the City of

Wellston that translated the three core goals of Choice Neighborhoods—Housing, People, and Neighborhood—into a strategy that recommended re-directing investments among a range of public and private partners to address interdependent neighborhood challenges, utilize data to set and monitor progress toward implementation goals, and engage community stakeholders and residents in meaningful decision-making roles. This work was conducted through H3 Studio, providing three internship opportunities for students from the graduate school and a study through the Metropolitan Sustainability course.

**2015-14 Women’s Society of Washington University Grant
for West End Neighborhood Sustainability Plan**

The goal was to create a community-driven sustainability plan that outlined the challenges, assets, and a series of proposals for the West End Neighborhood to achieve an economically, environmentally, and socially sustainable future. Students learned the valuable skills not only of contemporary methodologies of sustainability planning, but also of engaging residents and stakeholders to achieve a unique and community-driven sustainability plan. The plan served to expand the greater community of the University by advancing engagement and investment in the West End Neighborhood, a diverse but struggling community.
