# Steedman Student Summer Research Grants

## **Call for Applications**

The Sam Fox School of Design & Visual Arts is currently accepting applications for the Steedman Student Summer Research Grants, which offer architecture students the opportunity to pursue travel-based research on a topic pertaining to the built environment. Students may choose to pursue a personal inquiry in architecture or to deepen an investigation into an architectural area of interest that may have emerged from prior work in studios or courses. This grant has been developed as part of the international Steedman Fellowship in Architecture in partnership with the Sam Fox School and AIA St. Louis to extend travel-based research support to students.

## Description

Grants are awarded annually. For the 2022 cycle, up to two \$5,000 awards will be given to up to two qualifying students to pursue travel-based research during summer 2022. Funds may only be used by the awardee for travel expenses, entry fees, and materials. Funds may not be used toward tuition or for-credit academic programs or courses.

Applications are due by **Friday, February 18, 2022.** The grant recipients will be announced in mid-March.

### Criteria

<u>All current undergraduate architecture majors and MArch students who will be enrolled in the Sam Fox School in</u> <u>fall 2022 are eligible to apply.</u> Research must be conducted during summer 2022. Awardees will be required to submit a research report and/or deliver a presentation in fall 2022 after completion of their research.

Grant recipients will be chosen based on the strength and viability of the student's research proposal, the design portfolio, and a record of academic achievement. The committee will look most favorably upon proposals that are narrow in scope, to allow for a rigorous investigation of the subject, and evidence of serious intellectual preparation for the work. Prior to applying, students are encouraged to find a faculty member who can be a mentor throughout their project.

## Application and Submission

Submissions must include the following, compiled into 1 high-quality PDF (10MB max) and saved as [LASTNAME\_ FIRST INITIAL\_2021.pdf):

- **Title page** with your name and project title, email, degree program, and projected graduation date, GPA, studio level, and proposed location(s) of research.
- **Research proposal** (2 pages max) outlining your central research question(s), travel goals, and the relevance of the project to your education and the field, with expected outcomes/project deliverables.
- **Travel itinerary**, including destinations and schedule. List any required travel visas or permissions and demonstrate proof of your ability to obtain them in time for your proposed travel (if applicable).
- Itemized budget.
- **A portfolio** of relevant design work (10 pages max, high-quality PDF).
