Mr. Tunecio Delon White was born October 4, 1977 to the late Earl White, Sr. and Shirley Ann White.

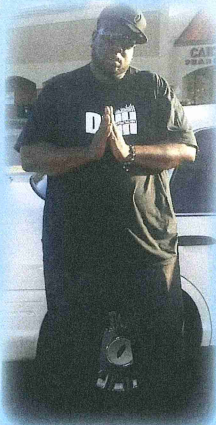
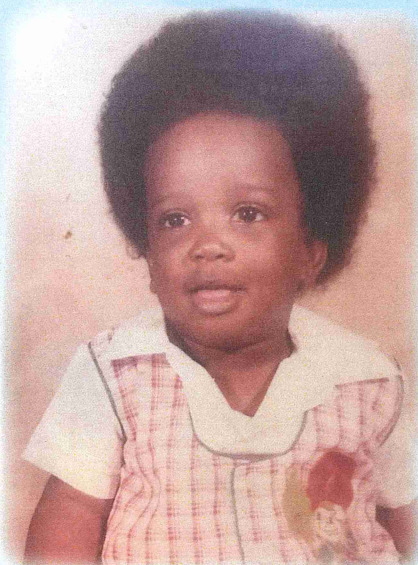
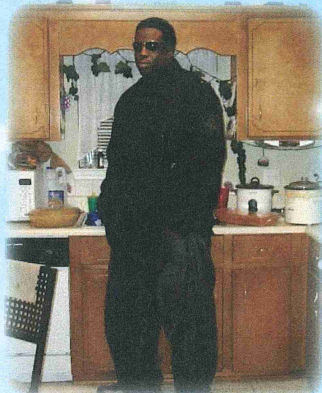
