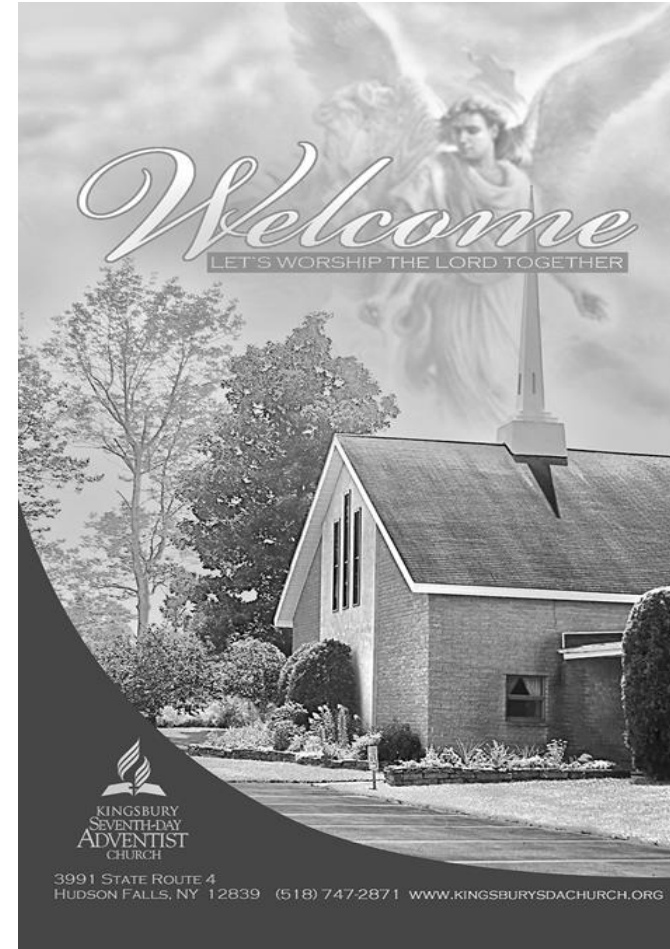

IN GOD'S WAITING ROOM

The two most powerful warriors are patience and time.
Leo Tolstoy

But if I change my thinking to, *I trust God and I know His timing is perfect, therefore, I will enter His rest and enjoy my life while I am waiting,* then I lack nothing as far as the moment I am in is concerned. Whatever God is going to do about our problems is not going to be hurried by our impatience. One thing is for certain—no matter how long we wait on God to act on our behalf, patience has the power to keep us joyful while we wait!

Nevertheless, do not let this one fact escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years is like one day. 2 Peter:3:8

We read stories in the Bible of those we refer to as great men and women of God, and most of us have secretly wished that their testimonies were ours. At least, we would like to be admired as they are, although we probably don't wish we had their experiences. They are indeed great, but let me remind you that they all waited in God's waiting room. Moses waited forty years in the wilderness. David waited twenty years to become king, and for fifteen of them he had to hide in caves to prevent Saul from killing him. Joseph waited thirteen years for his deliverance, and ten of them he spent in prison. Abraham waited 20 years to have God's promised child.
