GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDANCE...Six-foot distancing by families continues in the church, foyer, and Friendship Center. Note: Please observe the "reserve" sign and do not sit there! *Please first fill the middle of long pews, so others can easily find seats at the ends.* Up to 100 people are allowed in our Sanctuary, up to 30 in the Friendship Center, and 28 in the Youth Chapel. *Please wash hands/use sanitizer upon entering the church.* All are required to wear masks that cover mouth and nose. No congregational singing; humming is fine. A speaker or soloist up front may be without a mask with 15-foot distancing. Musical ensembles up to 15 people can share music up front with masking and distancing. Persons with fever, cough, cold-flu symptoms, or living with someone with symptoms should join by livestream at home.
