


## Generations in Ministry



## Message of Encouragement

Perhaps we are loved, but we cannot feel love, or we are truly not loved as we need to be, or we are loved in a way that we cannot accept...either way, loneliness can be crushing. At creation, God said, “it is not good for the man to be alone.” And God created a companion suitable for him and he called her “woman”...bone of my bone and flesh of my flesh...truly one. And then God said, “go and fill the earth.” We were meant to be with another, with others.

Every week, about mid week, my 3 ½ year grandson says, “I want to go with you, Nana. I want to ride in your van!” I don’t know how he knows it is “his morning” since he can neither read nor tell time, but he knows. So, we eat breakfast together, read a couple of stories, he snuggles in, I admire his Lego creation, and then we go for a ride in Nana’s van. So we went to the gym and played there instead.) How do we know we are loved? Because someone takes the time to be “with us” to “see us.” Someone takes the time to focus on just being together. God does that! God draws us to invite Him and then He is with us as if there is no other.

We long for that “oneness.”...a spiritual partner, a best friend, a soul mate, someone who can hear our hearts. Someone that we can trust with our inner self. Sometimes, we come close to that here on earth. God promises, that whatever relationships we are blessed with here on earth, He, Himself, will be our best friend, our confidant, our spouse, our teacher, our heart throb...He is all sufficient for those that need and want Him.
