Prison Ministries—Every Sabbath the women meet at 2:30 PM and the men meet at 7 PM for bible studies at the jail.

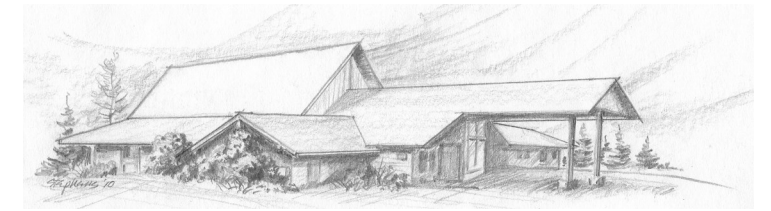
