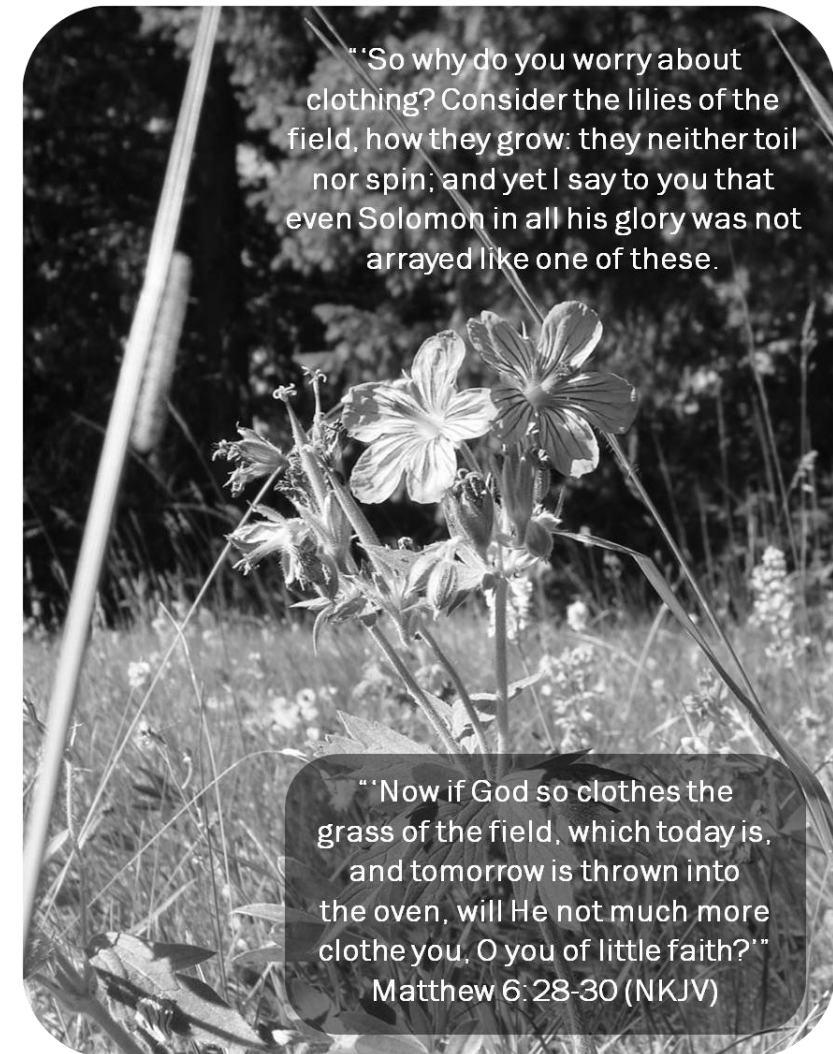

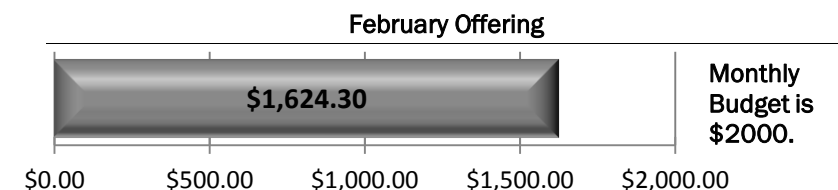

- ✿ **Treasures of Nature:** “Ice is a special sort of crystal in which the molecules arrange themselves in layers of interlocking hexagons... The large open space in the middle of each hexagon makes ice lighter and more expanded than liquid water. Because ice is lighter, it floats on the top of the water when it freezes instead of sinking to the bottom. Most other substances, though, are heavier as solids than as liquids. We can easily see why God chose to make ice unusual in this way. If ice were heavier than liquid water, lakes and rivers would freeze solid in the winter and all the plants and fish in them would die.” –Investigating God’s World, p. 231 (A Beka Book 5th Grade Science)
