This week in Bible we have been studying the book of Daniel. The students played a game to demonstrate how God uses prophets in each generation. We watched a video explaining the end time events presented in Daniel. Hopefully it can bring peace knowing that God is in control and he ultimately wins in the end.

In Social Studies we are reading about the 1500 and 1600s. Specifically about when New Spain expanded by establishing colonies in Florida and New Mexico. The students are making Google slides to illustrate their lessons.

In Science we are studying how to care for your body and keep safe. We will talk about different kinds of health professionals and how each helps to keep you healthy. We will talk about emergency preparedness and first aid.

Math for 6th grade is percents and 5th grade is studying operations with fractions. The 6th graders seemed to struggle with this lesson so we redid the section. Hopefully that helped them to retain it better.

In Reading the students are studying Dinosaurs. They are creating their own dinosaur using parts from different kinds of dinosaurs and coming up with an appropriate name using Greek and Latin root words. The students continue to study parts of speech with Mrs. Sharna.

Remind students to study for a Social Studies test next Tuesday as well as Vocab, Spelling and MV on Friday.
