BUT NEVER MEANT TO STAY...

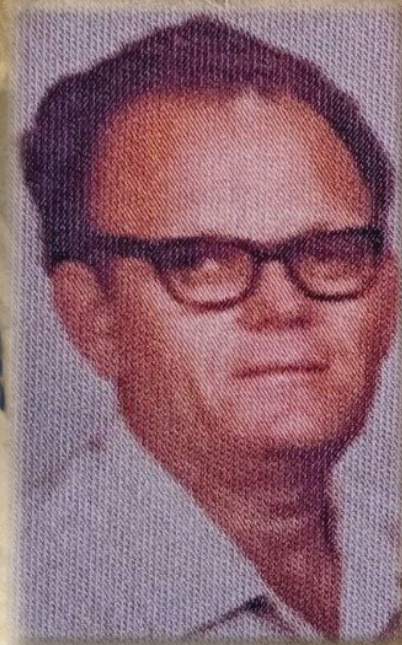
OUR DESTINATION IS A PLACE,
