RAS Early Registration for 19-20 Opens tomorrow, March 1

Both new and current students are eligible to pay enrollment fees for the 19-20 school year.

Early: \$175 (March 1-31)
Regular: \$225 (April 1-June 9)
Summer: \$250 (June 10 and after)

Current students are guaranteed a seat in classrooms until March 31. Starting April 1, open seats are available to new students. If you haven't registered by the end of March, your child may not have a space in the classroom. Both 5/6 and 7/8 classrooms look to be totally full next year. We want all our current students back so make sure you get this taken care of in March!
