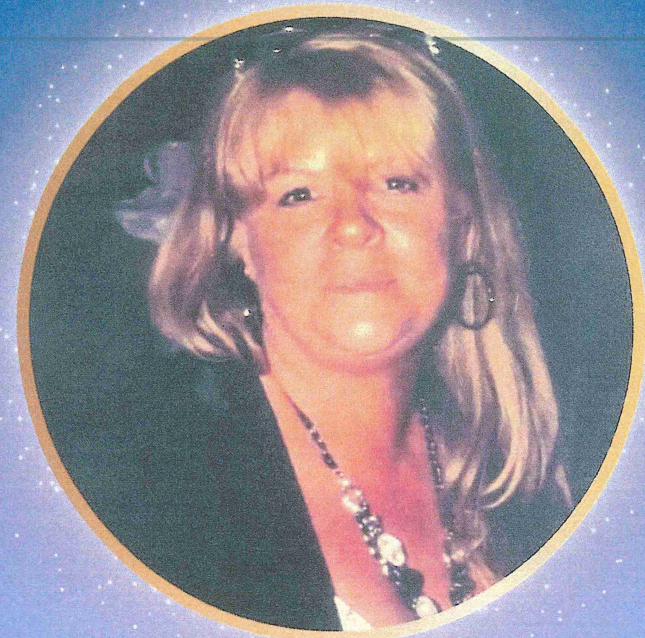


"The Broken Chain"

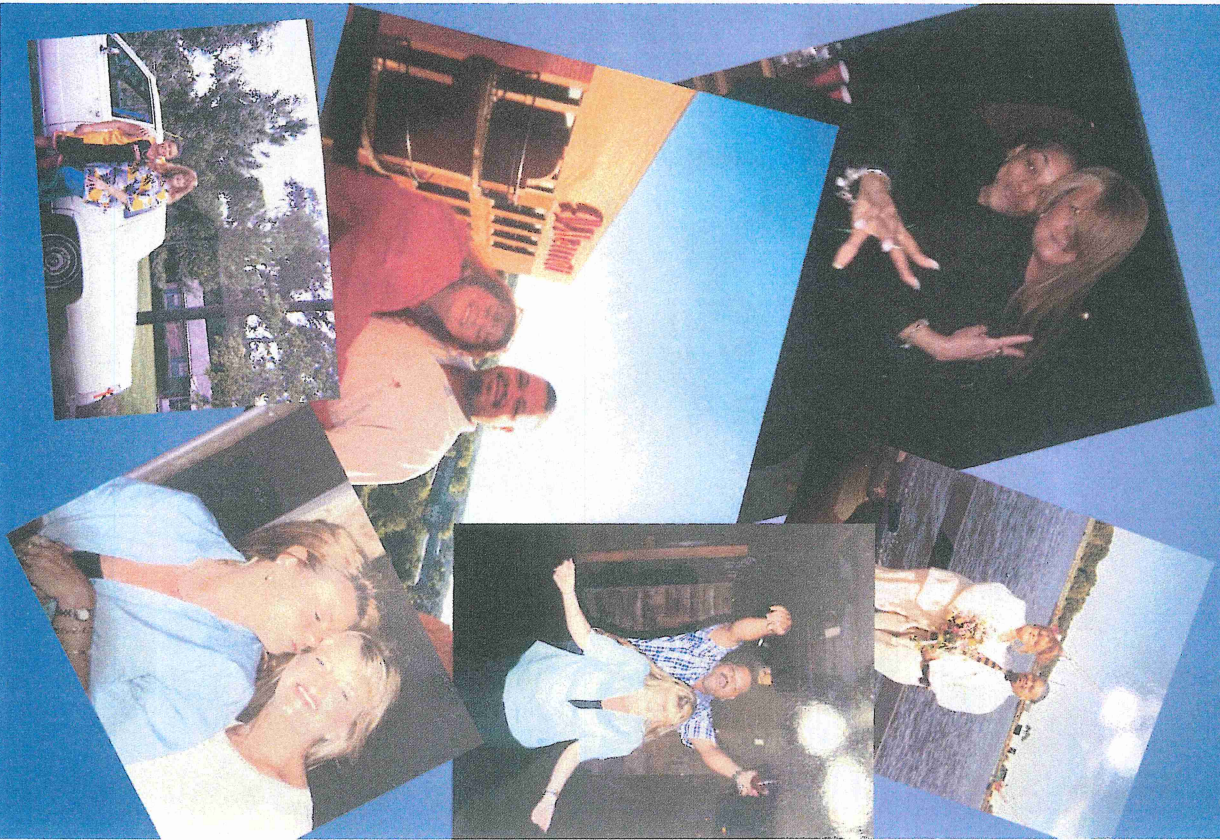
