I ALMOST LAUGH IN PLEASURE: AT THE TROPHY I'VE CAUGHT.

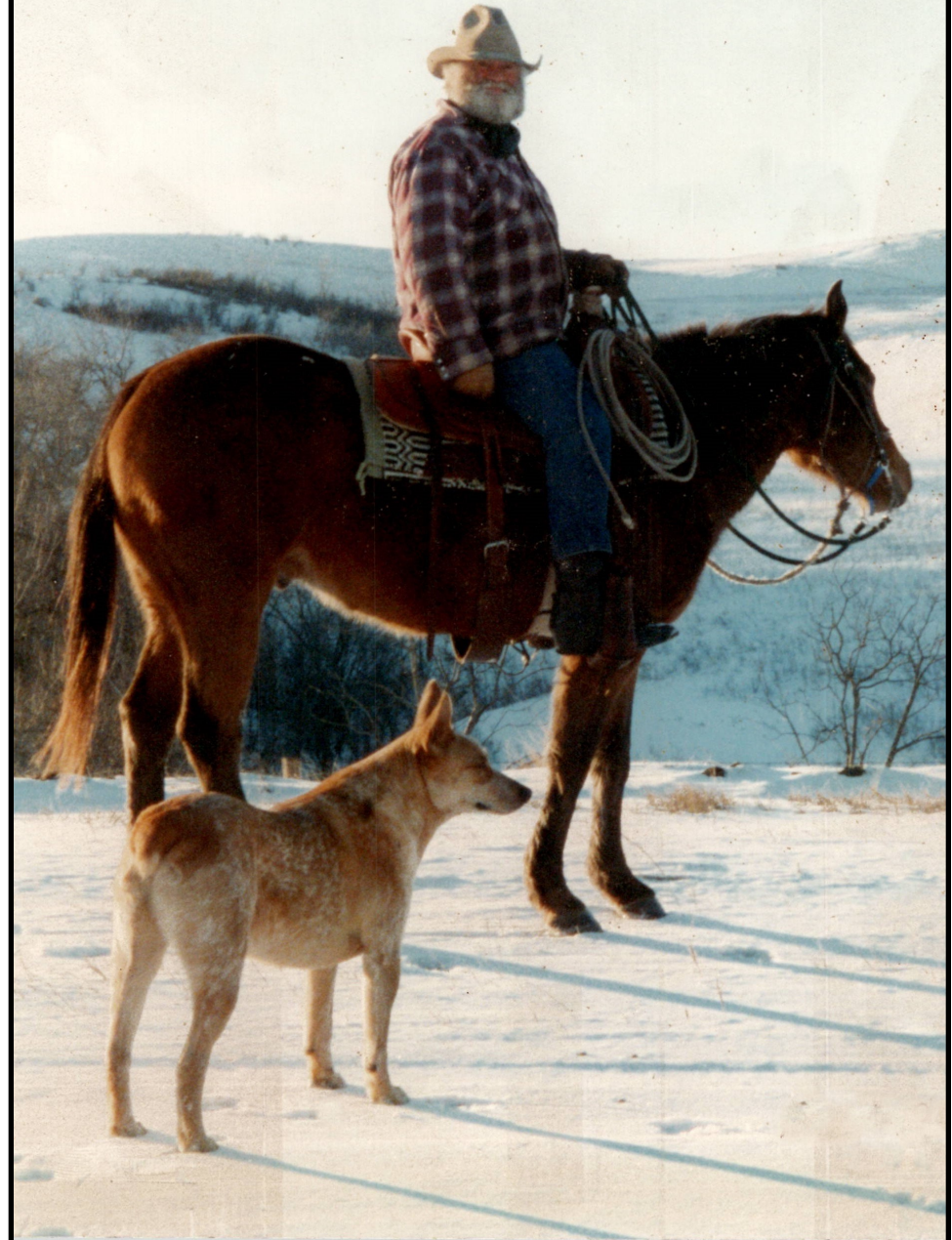

Mark Voigt, age 84, Mandan, passed away April 21, 2023, at Sanford Health, Bismarck, surrounded by family.

Mark was born in Elbowoods, ND, on October 31, 1938, the fourth of 14 children and the oldest of the ten sons to Frank and Emma (Gress) Voigt.
