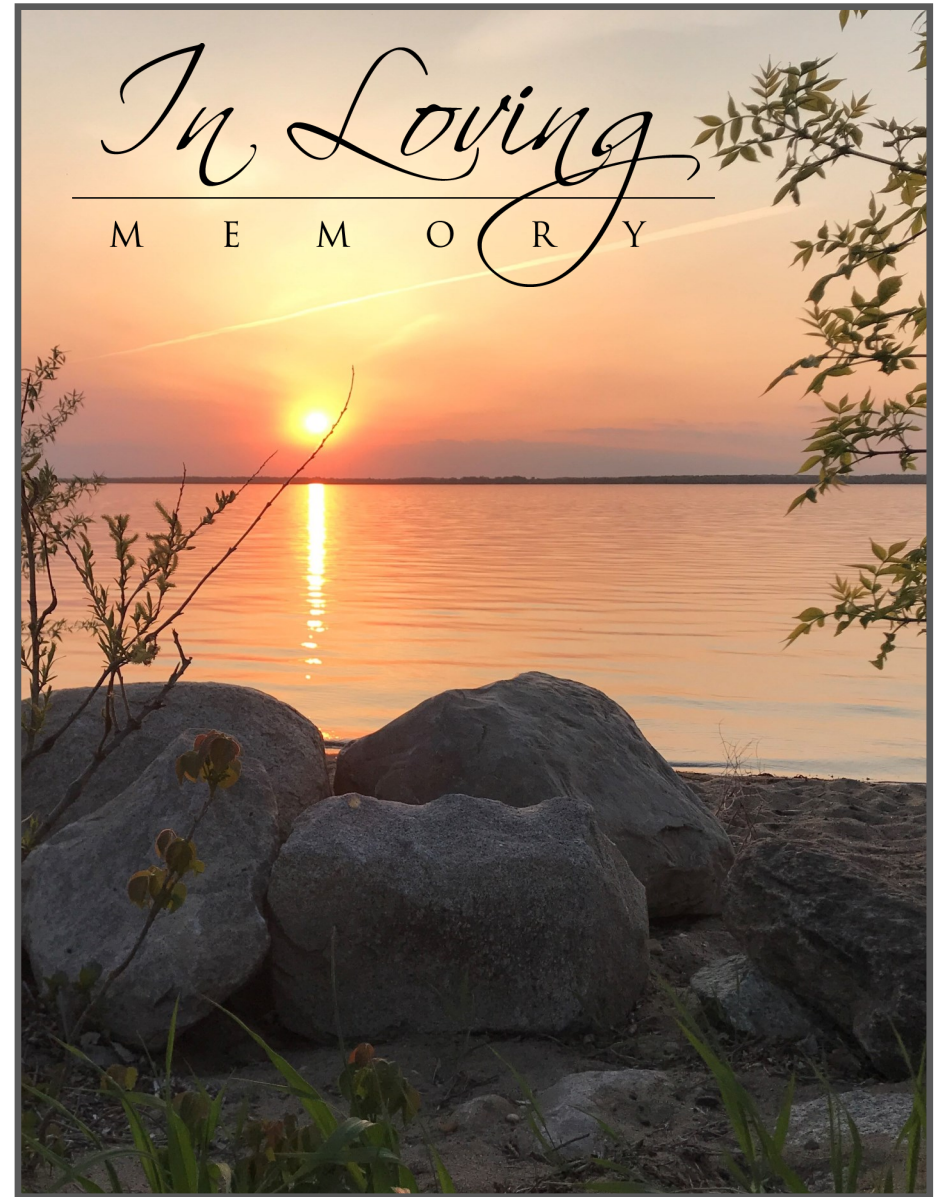
On September 14, 1990, Heidi was united in marriage to Kenneth Renowski in Walker.
