Psalms 121

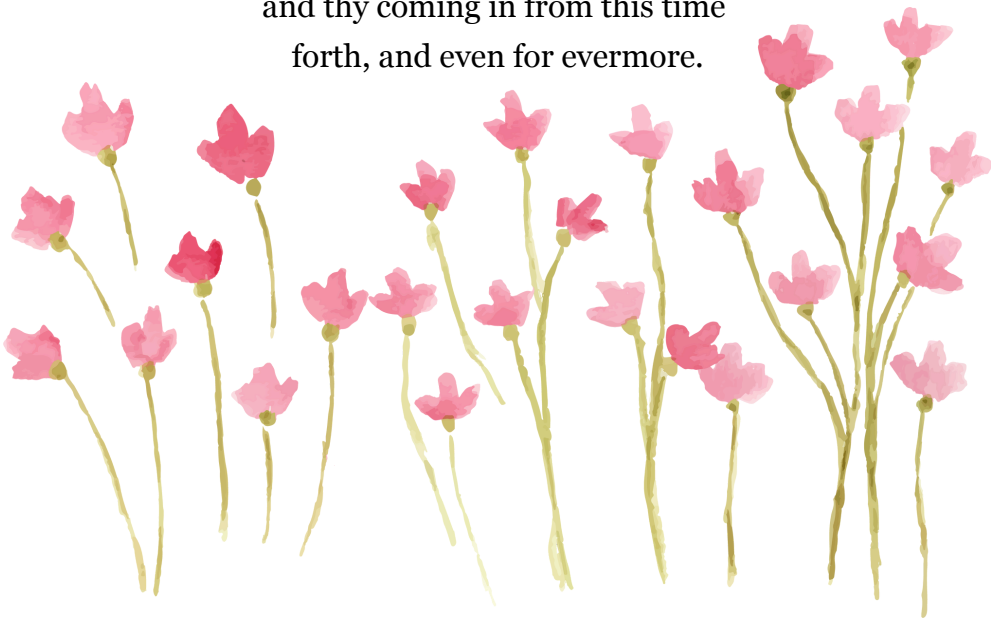
I will lift up my eyes unto the hills,
