“Greatness is not being strong, but using strength to carry the most hearts.”

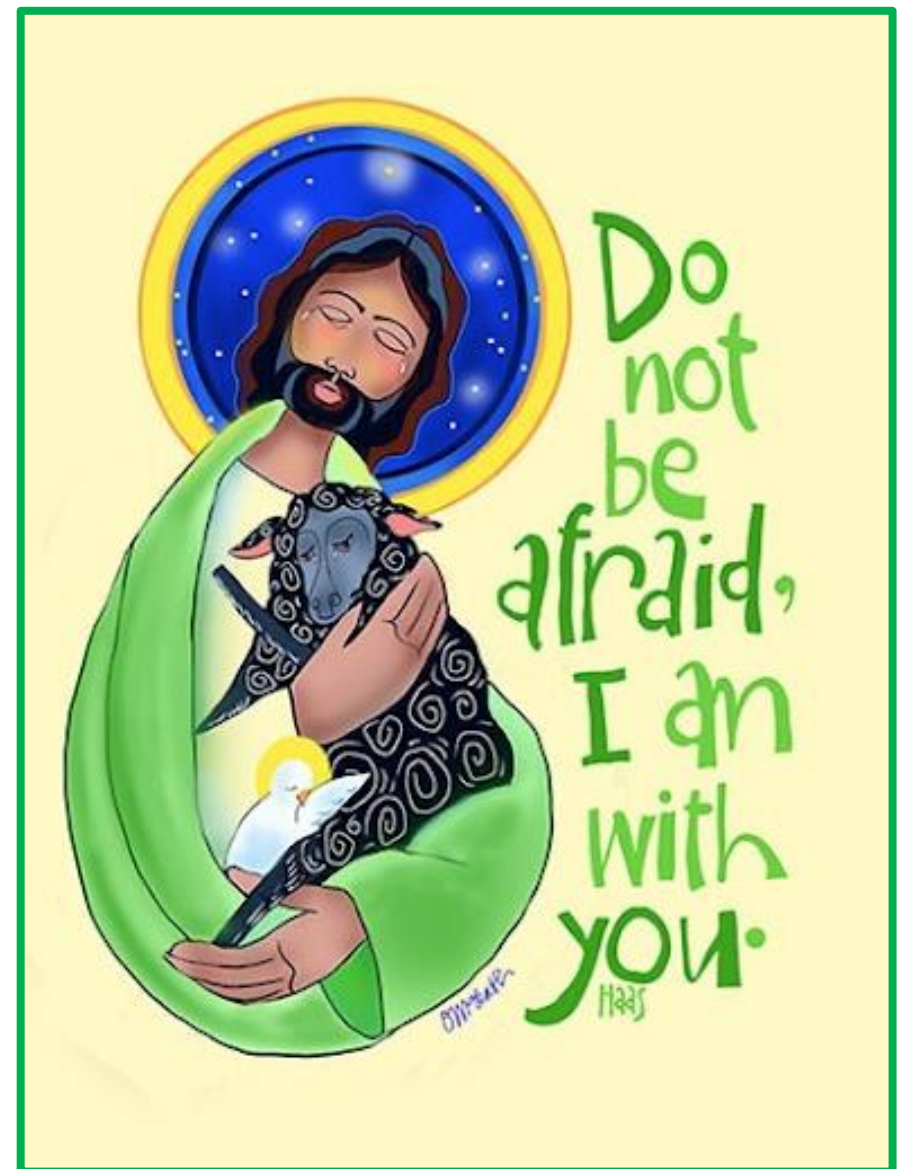
“We carry with us, as human beings, not just the capacity to be kind, but the very choice of kindness.”
