In these interactive songwriting workshops, our teaching artists introduce the concepts of real vs processed food and learn about songwriting and musical concepts like rhythm and form. Under the guidance of our singer-songwriter teaching artists, the students write their own lyrics to the song "Real Food Rules" and then record their own version of the song. A video is created with all the participating students and shared with the School District and posted on YouTube.
