

"Cleansed... to serve."

Hebrews 9:14

Hebrews talks a lot about the old and the new covenant, a debate on the definition of each that will probably go on until Jesus comes. But my method of studying God's word, especially when I am doing it devotionally, is to not get hung up on that which is not clear but to stop and reflect (meditate if you will) on that which IS clear. My axiom to live by—"If it's important to God, it's clear in his word."

So here, in the context of a discussion about the old and new covenant is a simple and clear descriptor of the new—I am cleansed of that which leads to death, so that I can serve the living God. I'm not cleansed to keep on sinning; I don't serve so I can get cleansed. I am cleansed by the blood of Jesus and my response to that is to serve the living God (and whichever of His children He brings into my life).

If it's important to God, it's clear in His word.
