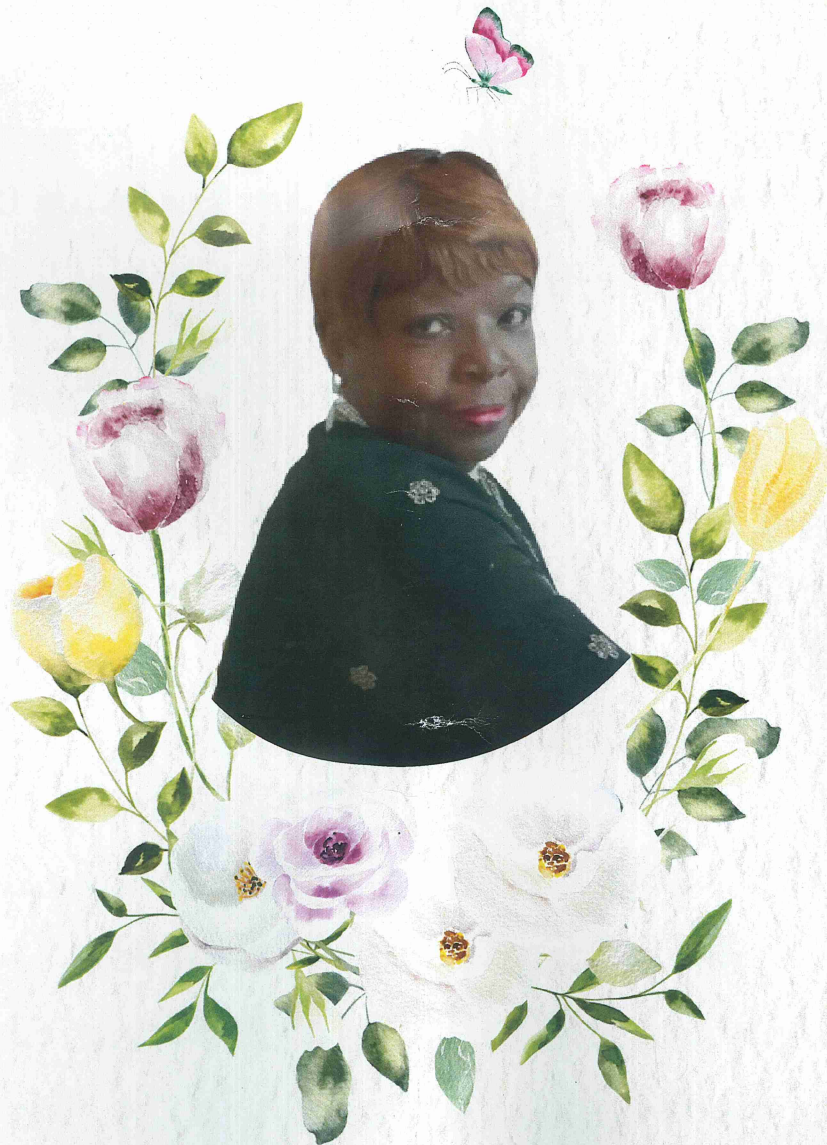

# Celebrating The Life of "Rose"

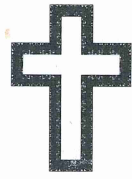
