Boil me on the thought

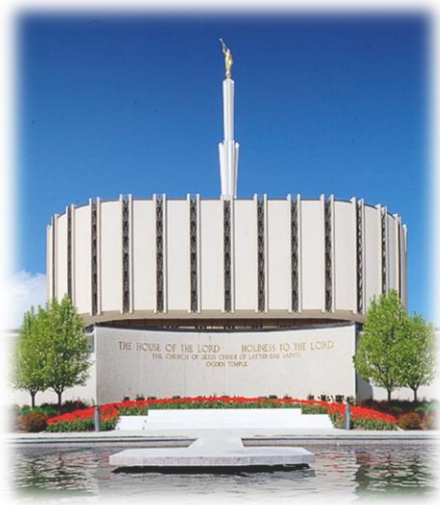
Beyond the sunset oh blissful morning when
