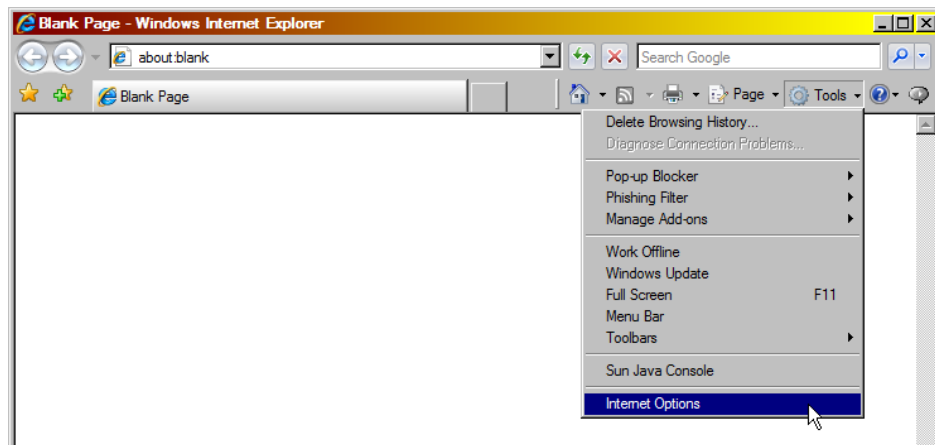

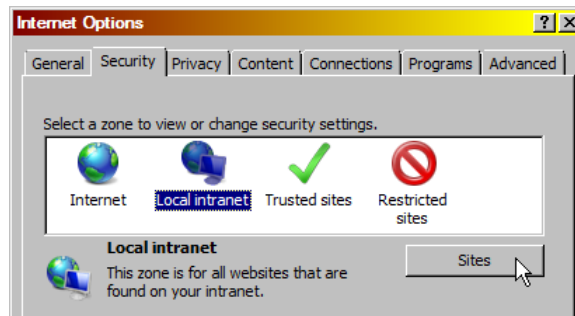
# “Unknown Publisher” Annoyance

Recent versions of Microsoft Windows and Internet Explorer will display an “Unknown Publisher” warning each time you start the LUCIS Software across a network. You can remove this annoyance by performing the following for each user workstation. NOTE: you will need to do this for each user who logs into the workstation.

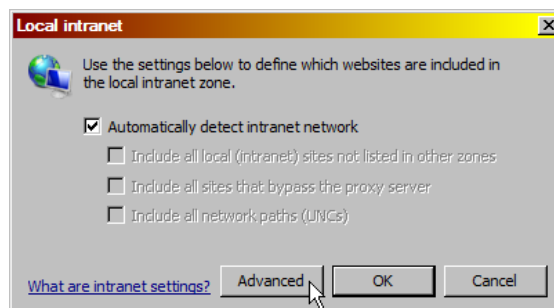
1. From the Internet Explorer toolbar select “Tools” then “Internet Options”.



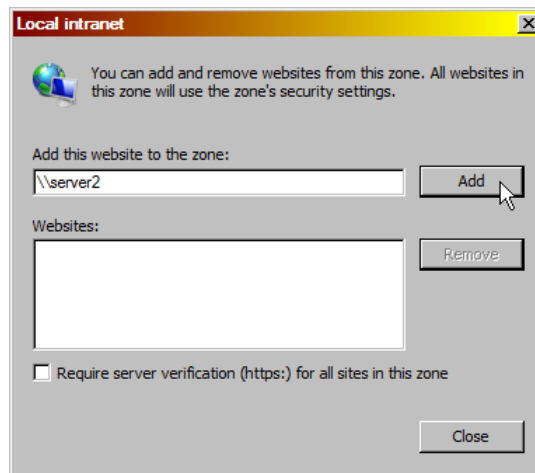
2. From the Internet Options window select “Security”, “Local Intranet”, then “Sites”.



3. From the Sites window select “Advanced”.



4. From the Advanced window enter the name of the network server where your LUCIS Software resides (the example below shows the name \\server2--yours will be different), click “Add” to add the server to the “Websites” using the Local Intranet zone’s security settings, then click “Close”.



5. Click “OK” on the Sites window (re: #3 above), then “OK” on the Intranet Options window (re: #2 above). The “Unknown Publisher” message should go away.
