Classroom

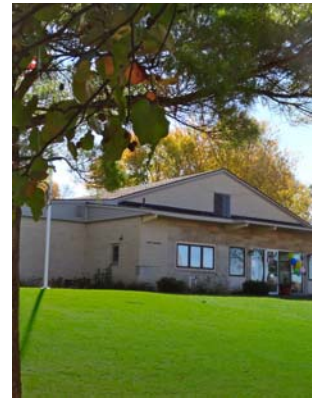
Our certified teachers and staff are highly qualified and hand-selected for their posts.
