

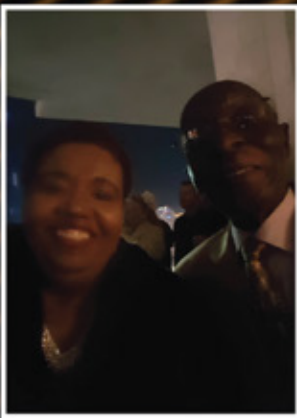
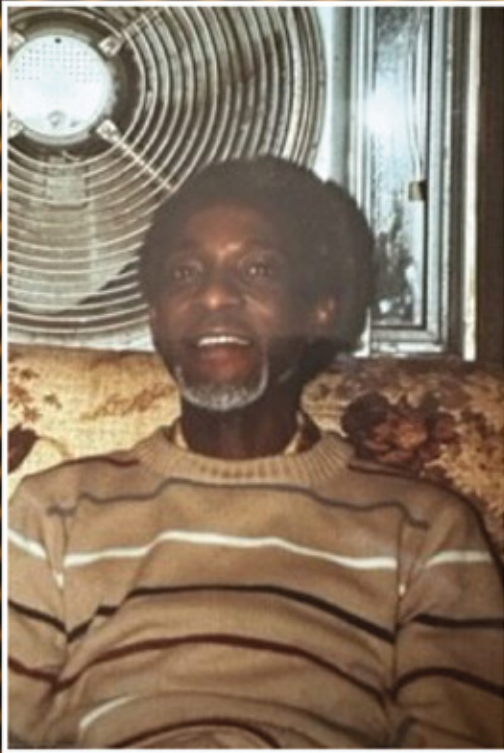
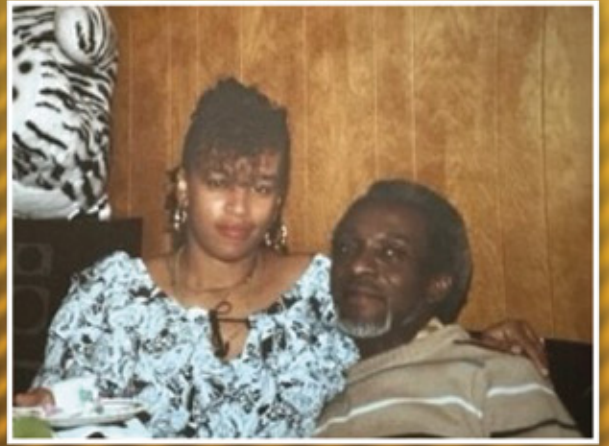

Demorge was seven out of eleven children.


