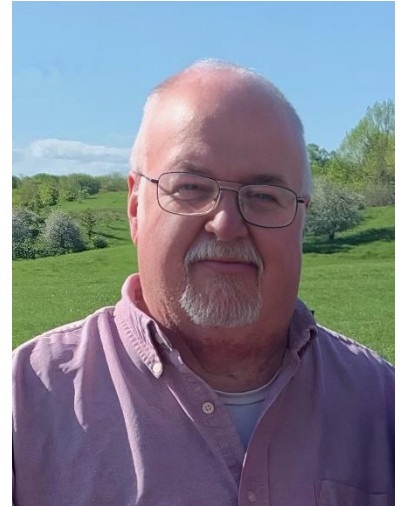


# Michael D. Hrivnak
