- ✓ Please bring a copy of your signed and current CPR card.
- ✓ Plan for ALL types of weather – cold, hot, rainy, humid, muddy, and just right!
- ✓ Please plan to attend an orientation meeting and meet & greet meeting – date and time to be announced as we get closer.
- ✓ IF you are not able to attend this meeting at this time please report to the medical building ASAP upon arrival.
- ✓ It is important that you have plans for meals as the days can be long and we want to make sure that you are well nourished and hydrated.
- ✓ Come prepared to work hard, have fun, develop relationship, and make a difference.
- ✓ Pray for the safety of every person who attends the camporee.
- ✓ Pray that we will be a witness to each person we work with.
