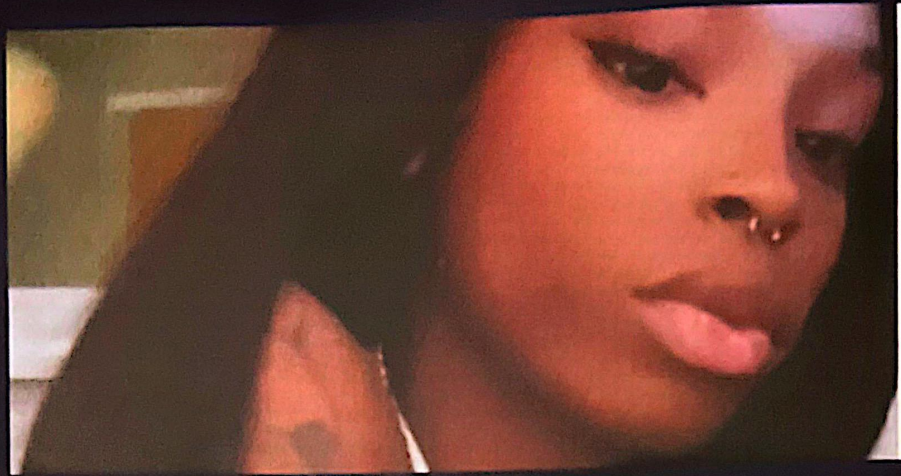

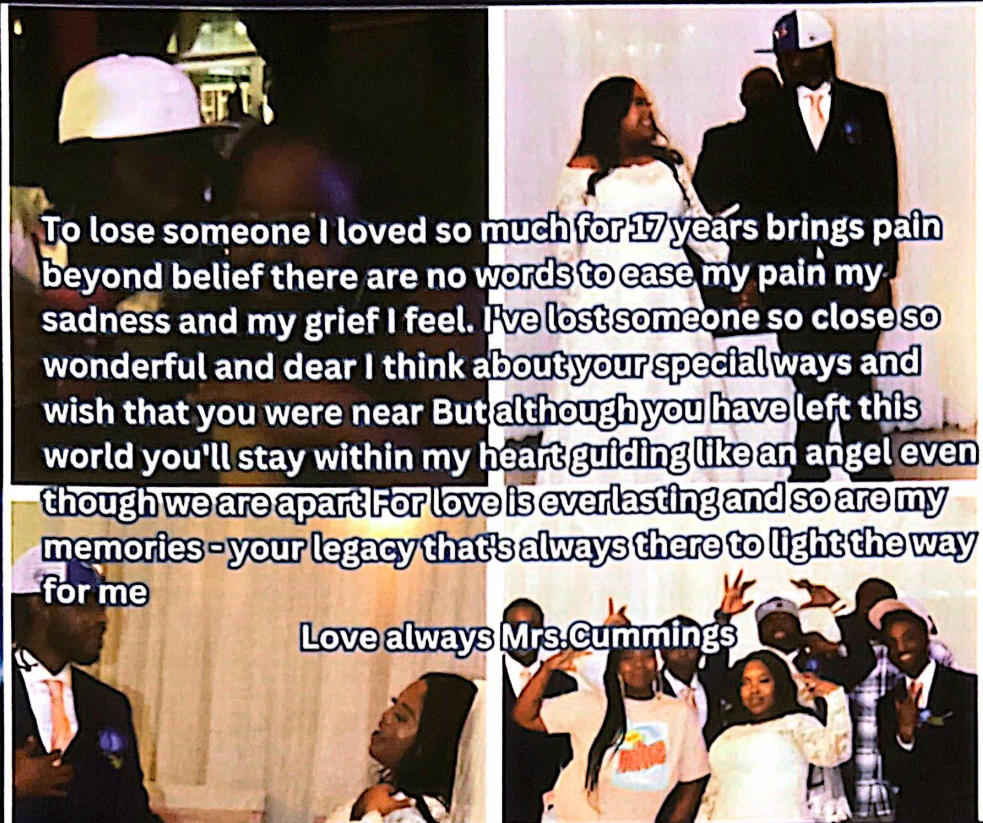

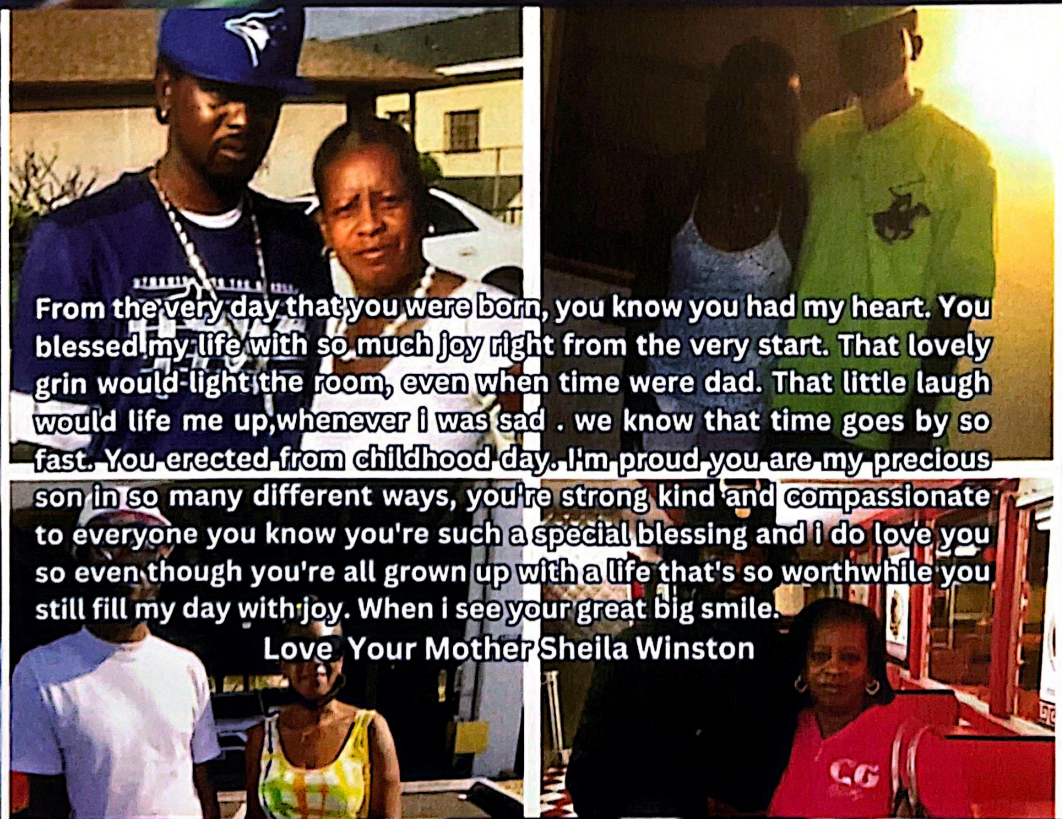

Dear Dad,

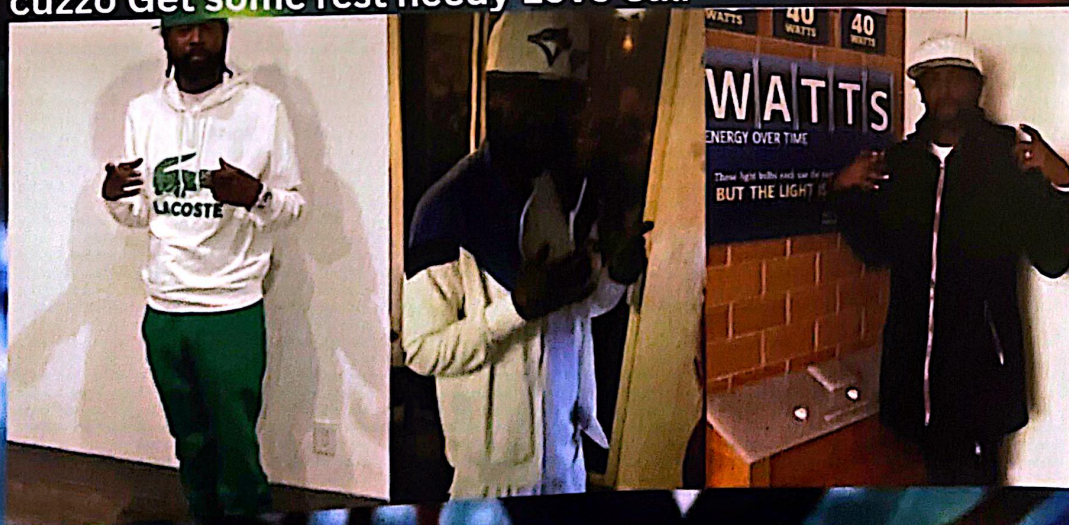

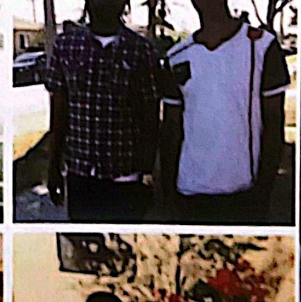
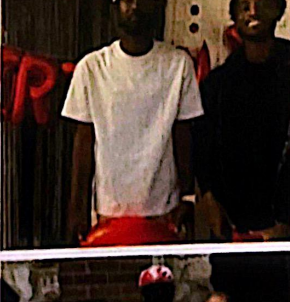
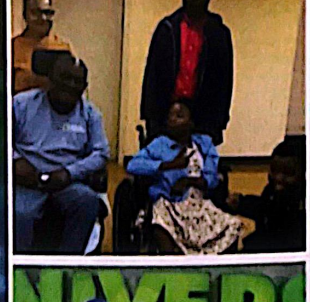
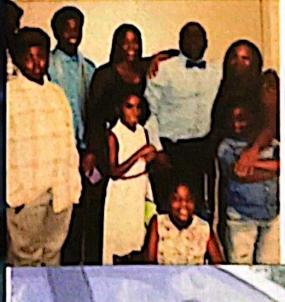
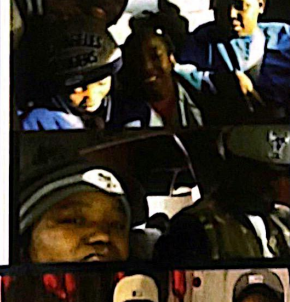
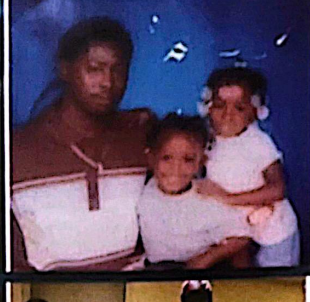
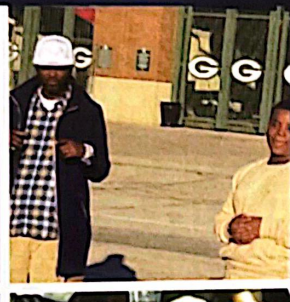
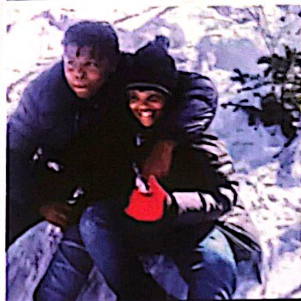
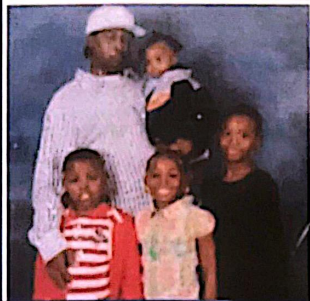
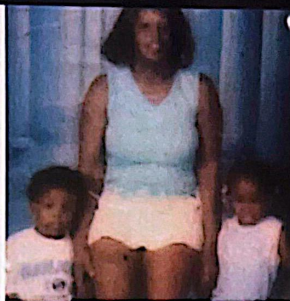


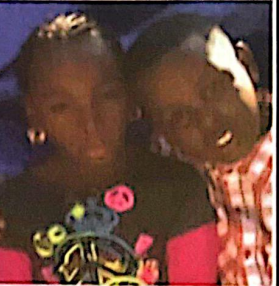
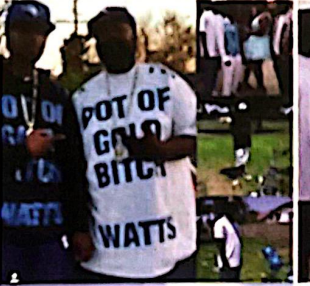
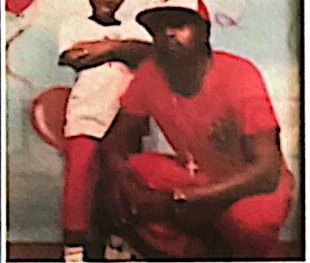
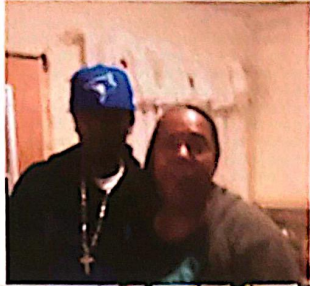
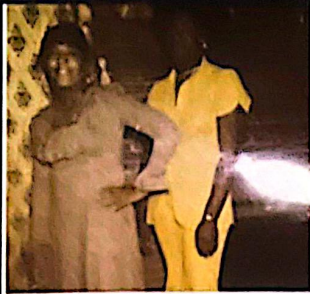
My big bro im gone miss our long talks you gave me so much
