Rev Alan writes...

It's APCM time! Please join us this Sunday, 4pm at St Peter's. The meeting takes place in an attitude of worship. We will elect our churchwardens and review the ministry and mission of our parish, then elect our PCC and Deanery Synod Reps (there is still time to offer for these roles). The meeting finishes with prayer and praise to God for all he has provided.

Our newsletter is packed with news and events, but there are two items I want to particularly highlight. Firstly, we are recruiting a **Children and Families Ministry Lead**, you can see details on page 2.

Secondly, to inform you that Peter Caffrey, a member of our PCC who worships regularly at Barrow Bridge and was at one time our parish treasurer, has been working on a parish-wide legacy policy to give us all the opportunity to make a long-lasting impact for future



generations in our community and parish. Here is what he has to say:

"Writing a will, and planning your funeral, are two simple acts of good stewardship. God entrusted us to use his gifts wisely, for the good of our loved ones, our church family, and the wider world. In thanksgiving, we should also take will-writing seriously – setting our affairs in order and stewarding them wisely to the end of our time on earth and beyond. Children and Families Ministry Lead

Could you be the next Children and Families Ministry Lead for our parish?

We are looking for a dynamic, well-organised individual who loves working with children and families and who will play a key role in developing and implementing our vision and strategy amongst children and families. They will take responsibility for the day-to-day operations including managing teams of volunteers across the four fellowships that make up the parish, taking oversight of weekly activities including Sunday groups, events, school's ministry, administration, publicity, communications, etc.

This is a part-time position working 22.5 hours per week (open to discussion about possible flexible working hours and term time only options), on a three-year contract, attracting a salary of £15k to £17k (equivalent to £25k to £27.5k full-time) depending on experience.

Mental Health Wellbeing Session

This session on Monday evening with Susie Mapledoram and Rachel Eden from Manchester Diocese was

excellent with 31 people attending. It was a very informative evening where Susie and Rachel shared about various causes of anxiety, coping strategies, what the Bible says to us



about this and how we should be encouraged to 'stop, eat, sleep and spend time with God'. We looked at 1 Kings 19: 3-20 where God sees how low Elijah is and He provides time for him to eat and sleep and experience that calm whisper of God's presence with him. We pray that for all of us, especially when we are going through

difficult times. As a parish we are looking to develop our care for one another, especially at times when we struggle with mental health. We are looking at resources, courses available and the potential to set up support groups. Watch this space for further news.

Friendship Group for those with Dementia



This lovely group met in the Parish Centre on Thursday and enjoyed laughter, a talk, music, singing and cake! This week is the Alzheimer's Society's Dementia Action Week. Alzheimer's Society works with individuals and organisations across the

UK to raise awareness about, and encourage people to act on, dementia. Here's a prayer for those living with dementia and their carers: *Heavenly Father*, we pray for all those living with dementia that you would pour your grace upon them and be ever close to them. It must be frustrating not to be able to find a word; fearful to lose one's memories. Bless them with patience to endure this devastating disease and with days of hope, communication and recognition. Above all may they in their inner being have an awareness of your indwelling Spirit of love and eternal healing. And we pray for those loved ones who care for dementia sufferers; that, in times of isolation and loneliness they will know your presence and comfort. Help them in their grief as they witness the loss of memories and basic skills of living in their loved one. Give them your peace and calm, and the ability to place their faith and hope in you and to reflect your love, comfort and peace in the daily care of their loved ones.
