**Dr. Manzoor Massey and Gospel Mission Outreach – Sabbath October 5**

Dr. Manzoor Massey is a people builder who has over thirty five of experience in conducting leadership training both in America and abroad. The founder of *Mind Realignment Training Institute* is known for his provocative, innovative and entertaining methods to bring out the best in his audiences. He utilizes role-plays, humor, educational games, theatrics and group discussions in his training seminars. His seminars are practical and down-to-earth. He has authored several books and written dozens of articles.




